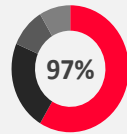

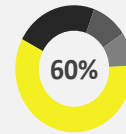


Student Population

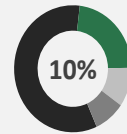
Our student population consists of approximately 800 students.
